# **Discussion of repair of carpet machine**

Price quoted was \$657.00 including tax. Mr. Gordon asked that Mr. Jones contact Gem Supply to negotiate a lower price.

# **HomeTeam Pest Defense services discussed**

Ms. Simone mentioned that another service is being investigated for external pest control, but that HomeTeam would continue to provide services inside for units that wanted it.

# F-building Elevator

A request was made for Beverly's update from her recent conversation with Oracle regarding the ongoing issues with the F-building elevator and its repair status.

### **Legal Liaison**

# **Termination of Florida Legal Group**

# 7<sup>th</sup> Floor Lockout

Mr. DeMarino clarified for Ms. Asmer, the issue of access to the 7<sup>th</sup> floor, by pointing out that the 7<sup>th</sup> floor is accessible by way of the stairs.

Owner Jerry Chalwick claimed that the 7<sup>th</sup> floor lockout was appurtenant to the residents of the 7<sup>th</sup> floor.

Ms. Asmer asked if the  $7^{th}$  floor continues to be accessible. Mr. DeMarino indicated that access to the  $7^{th}$  floor is unrestricted.

# **Improper Assessment Calculation / Water**
